

PACKING LIST

<u>All items must be labeled with your child's name</u>. This includes all clothing (including socks and underwear), sports equipment, shoes, and personal items (toothbrush, water bottles, flashlight, toiletries). We recommend <u>Mabels Labels</u>. We also suggest using ink labels (not stickers, even if they say they are permanent) for clothing, as these tend to fall off in the laundry. Laundry is done once per week and clothing is washed by bunk.

BLC Clothing

Brant Lake Camp does not have a daily uniform, but there are times when BLC clothing is worn. All campers should have at least one green and one gray BLC shirt. The rest of the BLC clothing is optional, but many of the boys like to wear it. BLC Clothing can be ordered on our AmeraSport Store:

Clothing

18 pairs of socks
12 pairs of briefs/boxers
1 robe
5+ sets of pajamas/sleepwear
12 T-shirts (includes BLC shirts)
2 sweatshirts (includes 1 BLC sweatshirt)
10 pairs of shorts (includes 2 BLC shorts)
3 bathing suits
4 long pants (sweatpants, jeans, etc.)
1 medium weight covering (i.e. fleece)
1 hooded raincoat (required)

Footwear

- □ 1 pair of all-purpose "everyday" sneakers
- □ 1 pair basketball sneakers
- □ 1 pair tennis sneakers (non-marking soles)
- □ 1 pair soccer cleats (rubber only)
- □ 1 pair of sandals or Crocs for showers
- □ 1 extra set of shoelaces
- Optional: non-metal baseball cleats (soccer cleats can also be used)
- Optional: rainy day waterproof shoes

Athletic Equipment

- □ 1 pair soccer shin guards
- 3 pairs soccer socks
- 🗅 l tennis racket
- □ 1 baseball glove
- □ 1 baseball cap

Optional Items:

- □ Mouth guard (recommended for older boys)
- □ Athletic supporter with cup (strongly recommended for older boys)
- Lacrosse stick/gloves/helmet (for experienced players only. We have plenty of lacrosse equipment at camp)

□ Roller hockey equipment (Do not send unless your son has experience or is highly motivated. Please note: elbow and knee/shin guards, hockey gloves, as well as a hockey helmet with full face cage, are required to play roller hockey)

□ Ice hockey equipment (only for those enrolled in the ice hockey program)

Golf clubs (we have clubs available for use)

UV protection sunshirt

Personal and Miscellaneous Items

- Toothbrush, toothbrush holder, toothpaste
- l Hairbrush or comb
- Nail clipper
- Dens, pencils, books, magazines
- Stationary, envelopes, and stamps (pre-addressed stamped envelopes helpful for younger boys)
- □ 1 laundry bag
- 2 flashlights
- 🗅 Extra batteries
- 🛾 4 towels
- □ 2 bottles of sunscreen (spray preferred)
- □ 1 bottle of bug spray



Optional Items:

- □ Shampoo and soap (we provide 3-in-1 for Freshmen through Inters)
- Backpack (helpful for older boys' trips out of camp)
- □ Music player without wifi capabilities (see page 13)
- □ Phone Charger (Senior Bs and Cs Only, see page 31)

Bedding

🛾 2 blankets

All boys should bring 2 blankets. We recommend the Amerasport forest green ultra plush fleece blanket, but another style is fine. Please keep in mind large comforters are not necessary and difficult to wash.

Brant Lake provides a bottom sheet, pillow, and pillowcases. Campers are welcome to bring their own sheets or pillows, but they are not required. Please be mindful of the size of any additional bedding you send. Large egg crates/mattress pads often do not fit under camp sheets and cannot be washed in our laundry facilities.

Camp will supply additional blankets for particularly cold Adirondack nights. Campers will **not** be permitted to sleep in sleeping bags as it is not hygienic to do so for an extended period of time.

PACKING LIST CONTINUED

Please DO NOT pack or send to camp any of the following items:

- Cell phones (separate policy for Senior B's and C's see page 31)
- Walkie-talkies
- Any device with internet or WiFi capability. This includes tablets, iPod touches, Apple Watches, etc.
- Electric/electronic appliances, such as a computer, refrigerator, or space heater
- Plug-in fans (battery operated fans are permitted)
- Expensive headphones, earbuds, and/or speakers
- Valuables including expensive watches or jewelry
- Valuable trading cards
- Food including bottled water, gum, powdered drink mix, sunflower seeds, or candy
- Knives or weapons of any kind
- Skateboards, hoverboards, or sneakers with wheels
- Inflatable chairs, bungee chairs, cardboard/plastic storage drawers

Valuables at Camp:

Camp bunks are not conducive to the protection of valuables. Boys should therefore avoid bringing items that they will regret bringing if lost or damaged. Unfortunately, some things can disappear over the course of the summer, and we cannot be responsible for lost or broken items.
